FargoRate

FargoRate will be used to calculate all divisions. Players with at least 200 games of data in the FargoRate system have an established rating. Those with fewer than 200 games have a transitional rating based on any data in the FargoRate system and a starter rating assigned by the BCAPL. Example: John has a computed Fargo Rating of 593 based on just 50 games. He was assigned a starter rating of 560 by the BCAPL. John’s transitional rating would be calculated by a proportional combination of the two numbers $(593 \times 25\%) + (560 \times 75\%)$. Therefore, John’s transitional rating would be 568. Starter ratings may be adjusted at the discretion of Oklahoma BCAPL at any time.

FargoRate for Divisions

- The team’s combined Fargo (Scotch & Teams) cannot exceed the limit set for the division at the time of registration. After registration forms are received, Fargo’s will be locked. At the time of the Event, Fargo’s cannot exceed 20 points Max per team. If exceeded teams **MUST** move up to the next division, if no higher division is available, team must remove a player to fall under that Division Cap or be disqualified and no refunds/and or prize money will be given.

Division Start Times

Divisions may begin as early as 9 AM on the date listed on the entry form. However, various factors could delay start times. Check the tournament brackets for the exact start time of your match or ask the Tournament Director.

Don’t Get Disqualified!

We take player ratings very seriously. A player who intentionally enters an event with a transitional or starter rating that is too low for his or her ability, is cheating. **Be aware that we have tools in place to monitor players who are consistently and significantly performing above their rating during the event.** Oklahoma BCAPL reserves the right to disqualify any player without a refund. Therefore, if you believe you are underrated, contact Oklahoma BCAPL OR YOUR LEAGUE OPERATOR prior to the registration deadline.

No Changes after the Draw!

Brackets will be put online to verify all individuals/Teams are added correctly, if changes are required, brackets may be taken down and modified to add these individuals/Teams and require a Redraw, Once the changes are made and brackets are drawn for a division and all changes are good, no changes are allowed after.

Know Your Match Time & Location! - THIS WILL BE DETERMINED BY DIRECTOR

Matches are not announced at the event. You are responsible for knowing when and where your matches are scheduled. If you need help, please ask staff at the Tournament Director’s desk.

Identification!

Photo ID’s of players must be presented to all opposing teams or tournament staff upon request.

Dress Code (described below)

In some State and Regional events, the dress code is relaxed. The decision to relax the dress code for select events is at the sole discretion of Oklahoma BCAPL.

• This Dress Code applies to anyone inside the Venue Ballroom. You will be asked to change or leave. – no exceptions.

Shirts:

- UTG, polo or button-down style shirt with sleeves and fold-over collar or other. (UTG brand collars are permitted).
- T-shirts are allowed but must be clean and neat.
- Matching shirts are **Required** for Scotch Doubles and Teams. (Not sure why I changed this from encouraged but not required)
- Current Year tournament shirt will be a neutral shirt and can be worn as Scotch & Team shirts.

Pants & Shorts:

- Athletic wear or yoga pants are **NOT allowed**
 - Leggings/jeggings are allowed but must be “One Color” and must have back patch style pockets. Sheer leggings **NOT Allowed**.
 - Skinny Jeans or tights, filthy jeans are **NOT Allowed**.
 - Casual or dress pants or slacks
 - Neat and Clean jeans
 - Business casual or denim shorts must be of conservative length, (mid-thigh length or longer).
 - All shorts must be mid-thigh or longer.
 - No tears, holes, or designer clothing incorporating such features as a part of the design
- no exceptions

DRESSES & SKIRTS:

- Sleeved dresses of conservative length, (mid-thigh length or longer).
- Skirts of conservative length, (mid-thigh length or longer).
- Culottes

Footwear:

- All footwear must have a closed toe and be normal in the manner of its style and wear.
- Shoes with laces must have the laces properly tied.
- No house shoes will be allowed.

HEADWEAR:

- Billed or brimmed hats must be clean, neat and worn with the bill straight forward or straight backward.
- Skull caps, bandanas or head bands may be worn but must be conservative, neat and clean.
- Tams are permitted.
- Stocking caps, ski caps, or hoods of any kind **are not permitted**

Not Permitted:

- Sleeveless shirts or tops are **NOT Permitted** regardless of gender or classification.
- Cutoff shorts with strings hanging.

If unsure of any clothing rule, ask the Referee’s on duty!!

No Phones to be used in the playing area, Exception is the phone used for the CompuSport Scoring App!!

!! There will be a 1 Game Penalty for any dress code Violation, no exceptions!!

UNSPORTSMAN LIKE CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED and may result in EJECTION!

SCOTCH DOUBLES

The following divisions are for amateurs only. No player rated higher than 710 may register.

General Eligibility (all scotch doubles divisions)

- Players do not have to be from the same League.
- Both players must be currently sanctioned members in a BCAPL or USAPL League for 2026 and have a minimum of six (6) full scheduled weeks in a **single session**. We will allow weeks played from Aug 4, 2025, to count.
- The team's combined Fargo cannot exceed the limit set for the division at the time of registration.

Refunds

- No refunds after entry deadline without Oklahoma BCAPL Board approval.

Divisions

Players will register for a specific scotch doubles division based on the members' combined Fargo ratings. All scotch doubles divisions are true double elimination.

Men's Scotch Doubles

- The team's combined rating cannot exceed 1,250 at the time of registration.
- \$120 Entry, includes a \$30 green/admin fee, double elimination
- Entries are split Upper 40% to **Gold**, race 4/3, Lower 60% to **Silver**, race 4/3
- Men-Silver - Sun July 26, 12:00 PM
- Men-Gold - Sun July 26, 12:00 PM

Women's Scotch Doubles

- The team's combined rating cannot exceed 1,000 at the time of registration.
- \$120 Entry, includes a \$30 green/admin fee, double elimination
- Entries are split Upper 40% to **Gold**, race 4/3, Lower 60% to **Silver**, race 4/3
- Women-Silver - Sun July 26, 1:30 PM
- Women-Gold - Sun July 26, 1:30 PM

Jack & Jill Scotch Doubles

- The team's combined rating cannot exceed 1,250 at the time of registration.
- \$120 Entry, includes a \$30 green/admin fee, double elimination
- Entries are split Upper 40% to **Gold**, race 5/4, Lower 60% to **Silver**, race 4/3
- Jack & Jill-Silver Mon July 27, 4:30 PM
- Jack & Jill-Gold Mon July 27, 4:30 PM

“45 sec shot clock will be in play”. Any player put on the clock will cause the entire team(s) to be also. Players will be on their own to keep shot times to a minimum. Should opponents determine shots consistently exceed the time, a referee can be called to observe and make the decision.

SINGLES

The following divisions are for amateurs only. No player rated higher than 710 may register for mixed divisions and no female rated higher than 660 may register for women's divisions. Women are allowed to play in the Men/Mixed Division.

Check-In Not Required

Check-in for singles divisions is not required. However, it is your responsibility to know when and where you play!

Refunds

- No refunds after entry deadline without Oklahoma BCAPL Board approval.

General Eligibility

- Both players must be currently sanctioned members in a BCAPL or USAPL League for 2026 and have a minimum of six (6) full scheduled weeks in a **single session**. We will allow weeks played from Aug 4, 2025, to count.

Singles Divisions

Each division's start dates, races, and entry fees are listed on the entry form. All singles divisions are true double elimination. Players register for either Mixed 8-Ball Singles or Women's 8-Ball Singles. After registration ends, the field is separated into three (3) divisions based on players Fargo ratings.

Mixed vs. Women's Events

While women's-only divisions are offered, FargoRate provides the opportunity for women to compete on a level playing field against men. A woman rated 450 plays at the same level as a man rated 450. Therefore, women are welcome to participate in the mixed divisions.

Men/Mixed 8-Ball Singles

- \$100 Entry, includes a \$25 green/admin fee.
- Entries are split **Platinum** - upper 20%, **Gold** - middle 40%, **Silver** - lower 40%, races to 6, 5, 4,
- Mixed-Silver - Tues July 28, 3:00 PM
- Mixed-Gold - Tues July 28, 3:00 PM
- Mixed-Platinum - Wed July 29, 9:00 AM

Women's 8-Ball Singles

- \$100 Entry, includes a \$25 green/admin fee.
- Entries are split **Platinum** - upper 20%, **Gold** - middle 40%, **Silver** - lower 40%, races to 6, 5, 4,
- Women-Silver – Wed July 29, 4:30 PM
- Women-Gold -- Wed July 29, 4:30 PM
- Women-Platinum - Thu Jul 30, 9:00 AM

“45 sec shot clock will be in play”. Any player put on the clock will cause the entire team(s) to be also. Players will be on their own to keep shot times to a minimum. Should opponents determine shots consistently exceed the time, a referee can be called to observe and make the decision.

TEAM DIVISIONS

The following divisions are for amateurs only. No player rated higher than 710 may register team divisions. All team divisions are true double elimination. **Note: "Team Fargo Total" will be calculated from the "Top 5 Players" (Men's), "Top 4 Players" (Women's) Fargo's, no exceptions. If player changes are made at the Venue, the "Top 4 or 5 Players" will establish the Team Fargo Total.** Should players Fargo's be different from the Signup date to the Tournament date a Team Fargo Total cannot go over the "Fargo Cap" more than a Max of 20 points per Team. If a Team goes over, they will be required to make player changes to get back inside the Cap for that bracket or move up to the next bracket. If a Team is in the Top Bracket, they must drop a player or make a roster change to get back under the "Fargo Cap" for that bracket. **Any Team caught playing over the "Bracket Cap" will be an automatic Forfeit. No questions asked.**

Team Check-In is not Required.

Roster change requests must be made prior to the start of the division and final league standings are required. Photo IDs of all players must be presented to all opposing teams and tournament staff upon request.

Refunds

- No refunds after entry deadline without Oklahoma BCAPL Board approval.

General Eligibility (all team divisions)

- Must be either a sanctioned member of a BCAPL or USAPL League for 2026 and have a minimum of six (6) full scheduled weeks in a **single session**. We will allow weeks played from Aug 4, 2025, to count.
- All players must come from the **same league operator**.
- Subs may take the place of players with equal or higher Fargo ratings. EX.... A 520 Fargo cannot sub in for a 425 but can for a 525.

**** In an attempt to keep brackets on time in 2026 we will set Match Times at 2.5 hours duration. ****

- **At that time a referee will check progress, if games in progress can tie up the match, they will continue until completed. If a table is open, the next player in the order may start play while the other match is in progress and play till the match is decided, if no tie can be achieved, the match will end as the score is.**
- **If the match is tied at the completion of these games, the next (2) players in the order will play to decide a winner, regardless of how many games have been played at this point.**

Men's / Mixed Teams - 5 player teams, 2 player Core Requirement, Max. of 8 on Roster

- **Gold Division** - Fargo Cap 3000, race to 13, \$375 Entry includes a \$75 Green/Admin Fee, "Top 5 Fargo's for Cap"
- **Silver Division** - Fargo Cap 2600, race to 13, \$375 Entry includes a \$75 Green/Admin Fee, "Top 5 Fargo's for Cap"
- At least two (2) players from the same league team must play each round.
- All players must come from the same "League Operator".
- Mixed-Silver - Fri Jul 31, 12:00 PM
- Mixed-Gold - Fri Jul 31, 7:30 PM

Women's Teams - 4 player teams, 2 player Core Requirement, Max. of 7 on Roster

- **Gold Division** - Fargo Cap 1800, race to 11, \$240 Entry includes a \$60 Green/Admin Fee, "Top 4 Fargo's for Cap"
- **Silver Division** - Fargo Cap 1400, race to 11, \$240 Entry includes a \$60 Green/Admin Fee, "Top 4 Fargo's for Cap"
- At least two (2) players from the same league team must play each round.
- All players must come from the same "League Operator".
- Women-Silver - Fri Jul 31, 7:30 PM
- Women-Gold - Fri Jul 31, 7:30 PM

"45 sec shot clock will be in play". Any player put on the clock will cause the entire team(s) to be also. Players will be on their own to keep shot times to a minimum. Should opponents determine shots consistently exceed the time, a referee can be called to observe and make the decision.
